

We bring the fast moving start-up environment to help community.






Treat It Like A Project

Food Bruce Grey

What: A website developed for the United Way Bruce Grey for local food organizations to submit their data.

Why: To create a comprehensive visualization of food insecurity in the region.

The Impact: Helps with resource allocation, education, and the idea has spread to other regions.



OCC Vaccination Support Council

What: A website developed for businesses across Ontario to offer help, volunteers, resources and space for vaccination clinics.

Why: To aid in Ontario's roll-out of the COVID vaccines.

The Impact: Public Health Units were able to easily connect with local businesses.



GBHStrong

What: A website and app developed as an information hub for Grey, Bruce & Huron regions during the pandemic.

Why: Ease of having information accessible and all in one place.

The Impact: The website and app have been used by 25,000+ people and has housed many of our initiatives supporting local businesses.



Girls EmPOWERed

What: A STEM workshop for young Black girls in collaboration with BrainSTEM Alliance.

Why: To increase interest and opportunities for Black girls and women in nuclear power and STEM related fields.

The Impact: Girls aged 9-12 had the opportunity to participate in a design challenge and be mentored by inspiring women in the industry.



All in Ontario Challenge

What: A digital auction aimed at supporting our communities through the pandemic in collaboration with the United Way and Bruce Power.

Why: Many organizations that the United Way supports were unable to have their regular fundraising events due to lockdowns.

The Impact: Raised \$30,000



3D Printing PPE

What: An initiative to 3D print face shields and ear savers for local healthcare workers and local businesses.

Why: There was a shortage of PPE in the beginning of the pandemic and we wanted to help close that gap.

The Impact: We produced and delivered over 2749 face shields, and 3470 ear savers.
